Open registration for Cheerleading Tryouts

All children who want to participate in cheerleading must register to tryout, no exceptions will be made. Due to the large size of our community and lack of practice space, it may be necessary to limit the number of participants for tryouts. If this is necessary, we will accept registrants on a “first come, first serve” basis. There is no fee for tryout registration and there is no obligation.

The structure of our cheer squads will again parallel the structure of the football teams. Of course the number of football teams will not be set until after their registration, so we will determine the number of cheerleading squads at that time. Here is a **TENTATIVE** overview of the cheer squads: (Please remember that it may be necessary to make changes)

- 1st & 2nd Grades will be combined into 2 or 3 non-competitive squads
- 3rd & 4th Grades will be combined into 2 or 3 squads (one competitive)
- 5th & 6th Grades will be combined into 3 or 4 squads (one competitive)
- 7th & 8th Grades will be combined into 1 or 2 squads (one competitive)

Tryout dates and locations have not been set at this time. Once set, our website will be updated with times, dates and locations. In the past, tryouts have been held at Rowan and Haine Elementary schools during the month of April or May. Grades 3 & 4 and Grades 5 & 6 will have three nights of practice with tryouts held the following night. Grades 7 & 8 will practice two nights with tryouts to be held the following night.

The tryout requirements will generally be the same as in previous years. Student cheerleading helpers will be instructing the girls during tryout week. CD of tryout music will be available for purchase for \$1.00 during the first practice. There will also be a brief parent meeting during the last practice for each group

Registration and Uniform fitting will be held during May at the Municipal Center. Please download the following **SIX (6) forms**. Complete and bring the forms with you to Uniform Fitting in May:

- (2) Medical Release Form
- (3) Health & Fitness Evaluation Form
- (4) Attendance Policy
- (5) Stunt and Mount Permission Form
- (6) Information Release Form

In addition to the six forms, payment will be due in full for Registration, Competitive Camp fees and a 50% deposit on apparel.
