On behalf of National Sports Concussion Education and Awareness Program (NSCEAP), I am proud to announce that the Seneca Valley Junior Football/Cheerleading Association, in conjunction with NSCEAP, has created the opportunity for all student athletes in your organization to have a baseline concussion screening test completed for only \$10. This screening will help your physician make the 'return to play' decision with both subjective and objective data should you ever sustain a concussion. This clinically validated test is the same test used by many professional organizations.

The test is easy to complete and will only take approximately 20 minutes. All Star Competition Inc will administer the test at the field house.

This test is a baseline screening only. If you should sustain a concussion, you would need to seek medical attention. After seeking attention of a medical professional and being diagnosed with a concussion, you would need to contact All Star Competition at 412-262-1544 and schedule a post injury test. A post concussion test will be completed after symptoms have subsided. Post injury tests will be scheduled in 7 day increments if required.

Once the post injury test is completed, All Star Competition will send the baseline and post injury results to your primary care physician. This test is not intended to be used without a medical professional should an injury occur. The results of the tests will assist the physician in making the return to play decision. No athlete will be allowed to practice or participate in games until he/she is released by their physician. A note from the physician must be given to the president of the Seneca Valley Junior Football/Cheerleading Association board prior to returning to practice or a game.

The goal of the NSCEAP is to make a baseline test available to every athlete who plays contact sports and is at risk for sustaining a head injury.

Please help spread the word to all parents, athletes, boards, and organizations that baseline screenings are available through the National Sports Concussion Education and Awareness Program.

A post concussion test will be completed after symptoms have subsided. Post injury tests will be scheduled in 7 day increments if needed.

Once the post injury test is completed, All Star Competition will send the baseline and post injury results to your primary care physician. This test is only intended to be used in conjunction with a medical professional's expertise should an injury occur. The results of the tests will assist the physician in making the return to play decision.
